Letter of Intent (2-3 pages). This letter introduces you, the prospective student, to faculty and staff of the Southeast Asian Studies Program. Please explain why you would make a great addition to the program. Include the following: a brief description of your life, people and/or experiences that have made a lasting impact on you; in a cultural context other than your own, and your personal thoughts on (global) cultural exchange; your knowledge of Thailand and/or Thai culture; reasons why you chose Thailand as your study destination and your goals and expectations while studying at Payap University.

The Southeast Asian Studies Program presents many challenges to Western students. In order to complete your application, please answer the following questions aimed at gauging your "intercultural understanding."

Intercultural Understanding Short Essay Questions (5 questions)

- 1.) In many ways, Thailand may seem similar to your home culture. Modern conveniences such as mobile phones and large shopping malls abound. Other parts of life in Thailand will be more challenging. In order to maximize your Thai experience, you will need to adjust your thinking regarding how things "should be" and avoid operating under your home culture worldview while living and studying in Thailand. Knowing there will be many cultural differences, what do you imagine will be your greatest challenges in Thailand? How will you work to overcome the potential challenges?
- 2.) What are your expectations of living and studying in a country like Thailand? What final goal(s) or accomplishments do you hope to come away with after completing your study abroad experience in Thailand?
- 3.) Describe yourself as an intercultural individual. What experiences have you had (i.e. study abroad, living in a diverse community, working with multicultural teams, etc.) that have contributed to your intercultural communication and awareness skills?
- 4.) Please describe a challenging intercultural interaction you have experienced and explain how you dealt with the situation. What did you learn? How can you use that experience to contribute to your learning in the Southeast Asian Studies Program?
- 5.) Thailand is often seen as an *exotic paradise*; an indulgent, sensual, and *underdeveloped tropical tourist playground* for foreigners. In Thailand you may have easy access to many freedoms you do not have at home, and will probably get a lot of positive attention from Thais in a way very different from "at home." Keeping this in mind, how do you expect to navigate your new-found "fame" and freedom while behaving respectfully towards Thai culture?
